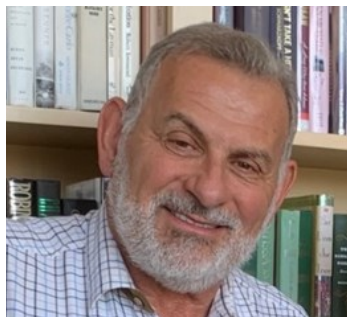
Bill Thompson, Treasurer
